Create a pivot table with Years in the Columns area and Months in the Rows area. Drag Revenue to the Values area. By default, the pivot table will offer a Grand Total column, as shown in Figure 4-55. Right-click the Grand Total heading and choose Remove Grand Total. Drag Revenue a second time to the Values area.

Later, if you have new data, paste that data in the blank row immediately below the data. These new rows will become part of the table. Select a cell in the pivot table and click the Refresh button. Excel will reread the data from the expanded table into the pivot table cache, and the results will appear in the pivot table.

Power Query also lets you manipulate data by adding columns, changing shape of the data or combining data sets. It is part of Excel functionality in 2016 or Office 365 versions. For older versions, you can download the free add-in from Microsoft website. Power Pivot: Power Pivot is a calculation engine for pivot tables in Excel (and Power BI).

To get the data in there, you need to right-click the name of the table in the Fields pane and then click Refresh data. The table should now be populated, as shown in the following figure.
